

FY 23 PSGP Grants.gov

There are two steps to the application process for the Port Security Grant Program.

Step 1 occurs in Grants.gov where you must fill the initial application.

Step 2 occurs in ND Grants where your Preparedness Officer will release your application back to you to submit the IJ and Budget Templates AND sign necessary documents.

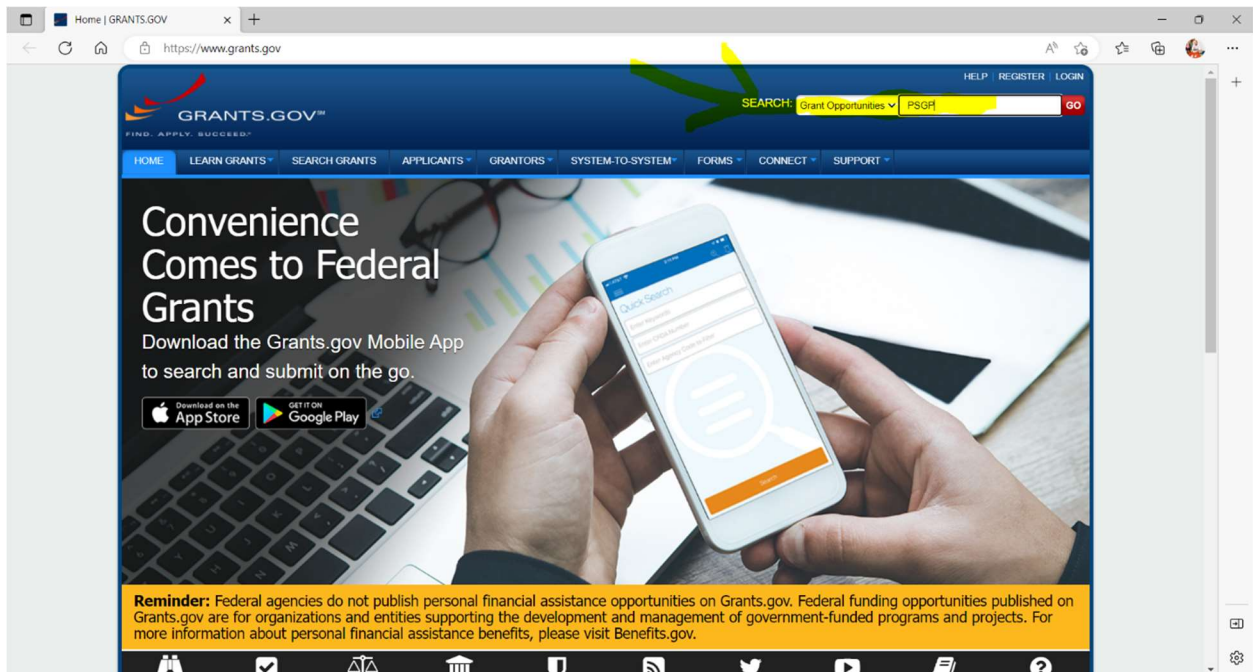
Both steps MUST be completed before May 18, 2023 at 5:00 pm ET. We would encourage that both steps are completed as early as possible. If step 1 or 2 is submitted at even 5:01 pm ET then the grant will not be accepted or reviewed.
